

TEI's Guide to Using Canvas

What is Canvas?

Canvas is an online **Learning Management System**. Each TEI course you take will have a designated course page on Canvas where you can access the course materials, discussion boards, and more.

How do I access Canvas?

Once you register for a TEI course, you will receive log-in credentials to the specific Canvas course page you are registered in. To access your course page, please follow these steps:

Before and During the TEI session

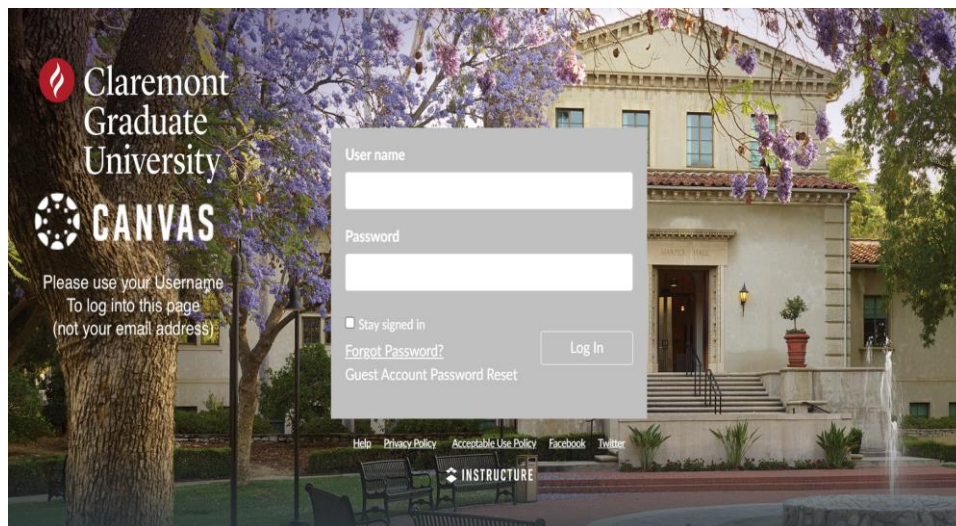
1. Visit the web page at cgu.instructure.com/login/canvas
2. Use the e-mail address and password provided in the TEI course welcome email (Subject line: TEI Welcome Letter and Connection Guide). Please note that these credentials will allow you access to Canvas for a limited duration of time.
3. If you log out of Canvas, and need to log back into Canvas immediately, do NOT click on any of the links on the web page. Instead, re-enter the web address above to log back in.

Note: If you are taking more than one course per session, you will receive separate emails for each course with specific credentials that you are registered for.

After the TEI session

1. At the end of the TEI session, you will receive an e-mail from admissions@cgu.edu (Subject line: Welcome to Claremont Graduate University!). This e-mail contains information about accessing the MyCGU Student Portal, including your CGU username and temporary password.
2. When accessing your account for the first time, follow the instructions on the [New Account Setup page](#).
3. After your account has been created, you can log into Canvas at cgu.instructure.com/login/canvas.
4. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset your password following the instructions [here](#).

Every time you log in to Canvas at cgu.instructure.com/login/canvas, the page should look like this:



How do I use Canvas?

Once you log in to Canvas, you will be able to see a list of the courses you have signed up for listed under "Courses" on the right side of the webpage. Once you click on a course page, you will see your course page.

The course page will include a description of the course and faculty, contact information, access to the **course materials**, **zoom link**, discussion board, and support resources. Here is the example of a course page:

3. Use an updated internet browser like Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, or Firefox
